Playing Times and Competitions

Members have the use of the course on the following days and times subject to alterations which the Board may from time-to-time make.

- Monday:** Social Play except on public holidays. Easter Monday is used for the Lake Macquarie Junior and Colts Tournament.
- Tuesday:** Lady Members between 8.00am and 10:00am. Timesheet used.
- Wednesday:** Medley Event as listed. Timesheet used.
- Thursday:** Corkers Social Golf Club. Timesheet used.
- Friday:** Lady Members between 8:00am and 9:00am. Medley Stableford before 7.30am and between 9.15am to 2.00pm. Timesheet used.
- Saturday:** 7-Day Members: Event as listed. Timesheet used.
- Sunday:** Open Medley: Event as Listed. Timesheet used.

Sunday Members

Sunday members are required to play at least 6 Sunday Competitions to retain their status and may play a maximum of 6 games at visitor's rates on other competition days including major events such as the Alexander Open, Easter Cup, Melbourne Cup Day and The Lorna Bennie Day. Sunday members are not entitled to play competitions at some other clubs.

Timesheets

Timesheets are normally available 2 weeks in advance of the competition date except for Saturday timesheets which are available 8 days prior. Electronic timesheets are available on the members' kiosk(s) situated in the Club House.

Saturday Timesheet

1. A "draw" is done on the Friday 8 days prior to each Saturday competition to allow eligible members to book their place on the timesheet.

2. 2 draws are conducted: at 4:00pm and at 6:00pm.
3. Members attending either the 4:00pm or 6:00pm draw are to place their name on the corresponding numbered draw sheet for inclusion in that draw.
4. At the 4:00pm and 6:00pm draws numbers are drawn at random from a barrel. A Member whose number is called may then place "1 time" (4 players) on the timesheet.
5. Time slots available at the 4:00pm draw are displayed as grey-shaded areas on the time sheet. Unavailable times are displayed in blue. At the 6:00pm draw the unavailable time slots turn grey and the whole timesheet is available for use.
6. Play will start from the 1st tee for most of the year. However, the match committee has the discretion to start the field from the 1st and 10th tees if the size of the field warrants this action. 10th tee starters are reminded to pick up their scorecards from the Pro Shop before moving to the 10th tee and to be as quiet as possible near the residents' houses.

Saturday Grades—7 Day Member's Competition

Saturday Competitions are conducted in 3 Grades

A: 12 or less **B:** 13-18 **C:** 19-36

These may be adjusted throughout the year to keep the number of players in each grade about the same.

Club Championship and NDGA Grades

A : 12 or less **B:** 13 to 20. **C:** 21 to 36.

Visitors Playing in Closed Season

In general only 7-day members are permitted to play on **SATURDAYS** in the **CLOSED SEASON** (February to November) UNLESS:

- ◆ It is an Invitation Day
- ◆ They are invited by a Member provided the visitor resides outside the 02 49xx-xxxx telephone district.
- ◆ They are a member of a reciprocal club.
- ◆ They are playing in a specially nominated Event (e.g. W E Alexander Open, Sunday Ambrose, Easter Cup etc.).
- ◆ There is a vacancy on the timesheet on the THURSDAY before the SATURDAY event, or on the SATURDAY itself.

Occupational Health & Safety

Green Staff have the right-of-way at all times. Do not hit up on Green Staff or perform any act that may place them in danger.

Do not hit up on other competitors or our green staff as injury to them could prove expensive to you.

Members' Attention is Directed to the Following Club Regulations

New Members

It is the responsibility of the Proposer and Seconder immediately a nominee is elected to Membership to see that the new Member is introduced to other Members, is advised of all Rules governing the conduct of the Club, and above all is sufficiently advanced in the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duty of Marker to a fellow competitor. Please see that you play with your nominee until he is so equipped. Rule books may be obtained from the office.

Members Visiting Other Clubs

Members intending to visit other Clubs are required to produce their Golf Link card at the other Club.

Dress

It should be left to the good taste of Members always to appear dressed in attire suitable for golf, such as suitable golf shirt, shorts or slacks and approved sport socks with shorts. Items of dress that are **not considered suitable on the course are:** ripple soles, thongs or sandals, abbreviated shorts, singlet tops, board shorts, football shirts, shorts or socks, tee shirts or shirts with excessive logos. **In the clubhouse** sandals and soft spikes are acceptable footwear while steel spikes are unacceptable. **Golfers need to remove caps or hats before entering the clubhouse.**

Car Parking

In consideration of others, members are requested to strictly observe the Parking Etiquette. Cars should be carefully parked in such a manner so as to enable the greatest possible number of cars to be accommodated.

Cars with Golf Cart Trailers should be parked on the south side of the Golf Club entrance in the area bordered by the entrance and the boundary fence closest to the main road.

Golf Club or Golf Ball Sales

Within the bounds of the Course, no Member shall purchase Golf Clubs or Golf Balls from Caddies or anybody else other than the Club Professional. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in Disciplinary Action from the Board.

Visitors

All visitors names shall be properly recorded in the Visitors' Book and signed by the accompanying Member immediately on arrival at the Club House. This is a requirement of the Liquor Act and must be strictly observed.

All visitors are required to produce Club and Handicap identification or Golf-link Card to the Secretary or Starter before commencing play. The visitor's Home Club and Handicap is to be shown on the score card.

Complaints

All complaints shall be submitted in writing to the Club's General Manager, who, if unable to satisfy them, shall submit them to the General Committee. No Director or employee of the Club shall be directly reprimanded by an individual Member.

Practice Rounds

Members are restricted to a maximum of two (2) practice balls and members MUST play off yellow markers unless permitted by the Match Committee.

Golf Cart Use

Golf Carts must be used sensibly at all times. In order to keep green surrounds in good playing condition **PLEASE KEEP GOLF CARTS AT LEAST 20metres FROM ALL GREENS AND BUNKERS. When past the cart signs/lines,** carts should **stay on the cart path.** When the course is wet and soft it is recommended that Golf Carts stay on the fairway, avoiding wet patches where possible.

Club Committees

Match Committee

The Match Committee is responsible for the supervision and control of all matters pertaining to the arrangement and superintending of all contests, the allotment and revision of handicaps, the settlement of disputes, the selection of teams and supervising the Professional and Caddies. To assist the Match Committee members' attention is directed to the following:

- ◆ Familiarise yourself with all notices posted on the Notice Board.
- ◆ Take out a starting time at the earliest convenience and be ready to hit off (10 min. before time selected).
- ◆ All ties will be decided on count back. Last 18 holes, last 9 holes, last 6, last 3 then hole-by-hole unless otherwise noted under the event rules.
- ◆ All complaints or disputes regarding COMPETITIONS should be made to the Match Committee before finalisation of the competition.
- ◆ Knock-out Events. All matches must be played ON or BEFORE the programmed date. Any dispute must be referred to the Match Committee for decision.
- ◆ Nominated Home Club. A player belonging to more than one golf club must nominate his Home Club.

Finance Committee

The Finance Committee is responsible for the supervision of financial matters in relation to the operation of the Club. The Financial Committee must ensure that the Club complies with all Laws that directly affect the financial viability of the Club, this is done with the aid of the General Manager and all other members of the Board.

Greens Committee

It is the duty of the Greens Committee to supervise the upkeep and improvement of the links and the Club's General Manager to control the services of the course staff. This

Committee should bring forward any suggestions regarding course improvements for the consideration of the Board and if so authorised, see to the implementation of such ideas.

House Committee

The House Committee is responsible for the supervision of the Club House and all matters pertaining to it and for the control of Club House services. During the year various social evenings are held in the Club House. Members are requested to support these activities.

Slow Play and Course Etiquette

Slow Play

- * Be ready to hit or putt. Mark your card on the next tee whilst your playing partners are hitting. If the player who has the honour is not ready then one of the other players in the group may hit. Shorter hitters should hit when the group in front is out of range.
- * *KEEP UP WITH THE PLAYERS IN FRONT BUT DO NOT HIT UNTIL THEY ARE OUT OF RANGE.*
- * If a player's ball in your group is lost, hit your ball first, where practicable, then join search.
- * Do not dawdle in clubhouse or at the 10th tee when playing from both tees (five minutes should be plenty of time). When playing from the 10th tee and the 1st tee and the fairway is clear then the following group may assume the right to play through. The same applies for the 10th tee and fairway for players hitting off the 1st tee. Penalty for undue delay - two strokes.
- * Select your club while other players in the group are hitting and walk briskly between shots.
- * If you have lost your place in the field, i.e. you have a full clear fairway in front, speed up your play and remember courteous players who have lost their place will call following players through if they cannot catch up to the field in front.
- * If necessary **2 practice swings only** should be adequate.
- * Be ready to hit off at least 10 minutes before your allotted

time.

- * In Par and Stableford events *PICK UP* when all strokes have been taken.
- * *SLOW PLAY IS SELFISH PLAY*. Your position in the field is behind the group in front not in front of the group behind.

Etiquette

- * No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is making a stroke.
- * Mobile phones should be turned off or set to the lowest possible ring volume or if available to vibrate mode.
- * Players who have golf carts should be aware of the noise they create and as such they should not be driven up to or past players during the course of their stroke making.
- * No players should hit until the players in front are out of range or are called upon to do so.
- * Study your line on the putting green while others are putting. You do not have to move about to do this, but you have to get to the position of your ball before the first player putts.
- * In interest of all, players should *PLAY WITHOUT DELAY*.
- * When the result of the hole has been determined players should immediately leave the putting green. Players should leave the green in a direction so as not to interfere with play for the following group. Record your scores at the next tee while waiting to hit off, while your fellow players are putting out or **after** you hit off.
- * Players should not leave their bag or buggy at or near the front of the green and if possible they should be left on or near the path to the next tee.
- * Golf carts should be on the cart path when past the cart signs in front of greens.
- * Players should leave **all greens from the back** when proceeding to the next tee.
- * Players searching for a ball should call the following players through and should not continue their play until

those players have passed and are out of range.

- * *A MAXIMUM OF 5 MINUTES IS ALLOWED TO SEARCH FOR A BALL.*
- * The lowest marker in each group is responsible to see that the rules and etiquette of Golf are strictly observed.

Course Markers

Red - Lateral Water Hazard

Yellow - Water Hazard

White - Ground Under Repair (G.U.R.)

Treated Pine Posts with White Tops - 150m to Centre of the Green.

Treated Pine Posts with Yellow Tops - 100m to Centre of the Green.

Metal fairway markers are either 200m (Blue), 150m (White), 100m (Yellow) or 50m (Red) as marked and are to the Centre of the Green.

Information for Members and their Guests.

Course Care - Member Responsibility

Every member has a responsibility to help maintain the Course in prime condition. In order to help achieve the high standard of playing conditions the Greens Committee would like members to take note of the following:

- * Players should ensure that no damage is done to the putting green, and neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing too close to it or by handling the flagstick. The flagstick should be carefully replaced before the players leave the green.
- * "Through the Green" a player should ensure that any turf cut by him is replaced or repaired
- * Lob marks on the putting green should be repaired before a player leaves the green. Players should repair other lob marks left by other less considerate players if playing conditions permit.
- * All players should rake/repair the sand (at all times after making a shot) from a bunker.
- * Players are not permitted, at any time, to place their golf bag, drag their pull buggy or drive a golf cart onto or across any green.
- * Players with golf carts are required to maintain a minimum of 20 metres from all greens and bunkers or as noted by either / or blue lines and cart direction signs on the fairway. Golf carts should always use the paths where provided, especially when past the cart signs/lines near greens and tees. In soft/wet conditions it is recommended that carts avoid the rough if possible.
- * Soft spiked golf shoes are preferred but not obligatory on our course.
- * Wide rubber non-inflatable buggy tyres are preferred but not obligatory on our course

By adhering to the previous points all members can help our course continue to be one of the premier courses in the region.

e) Four Ball (Irish, 4 Person, "Normal")

Full Handicap for Members

f) Match Play

Reduce the full handicaps of all players by the full handicap of the lowest handicap player or players, who will then play off scratch. Each of the other players is then allowed the full difference of the resulting handicaps.

Example: Four players "A", "B", "C" and "D". A's handicap is 10, B's handicap is 22, C's handicap is 15, and D's is

handicap is 11. "A" would play from scratch, "B" would play off 12 (full difference), "C" off 5 and "D" off 1. "D" would get a stroke at the hole indicated on the match play index for 1. "C" would get strokes indicated on the match play index 1 thru 5 and "B" would get strokes at holes indicated on the match play index 1 thru 12.

g) Ambrose

2 Person: 1/4 of aggregate total handicap.

3 Person: 1/6 of aggregate total handicap.

4 Person: 1/8 of aggregate total handicap.

3 or 4 Person Dropout: Same as normal Ambrose except that: all players hit drives. The best drive is chosen with the player who hit the best drive dropping out for the next shot. Continue with the same format until the ball is holed .

Ambrose Competition

The following conditions usually will apply:

- * Lowest marker is Team Captain.
- * Through the green, in a hazard or bunker, PLACED within one club length of selected ball, no nearer the hole. A ball may only be placed on the same type of playing surface e.g. a ball in the rough must be placed in the rough.
- * On putting green PLACE ball within 1 putter head length of selected ball no nearer the hole.
- * Longest marker putts then others in sequence if score can be improved.
- * Rules for tee shots may vary depending on the event.
- * Some competitions may require a minimum number of tee-shots be taken from each player during the round.

Double Par Competition

Similar to Par and Stableford except that a 4 pointer in Stableford only merits a single + in Par but gains a "double" + in Double Par events. Similarly a "5 Stableford pointer" would equate to a "triple" + in a Double Par event.

4 Person Split Sixes

For the 1st 6 holes - take the **best** score
For the 2nd 6 holes - take the **2 best** scores
For the last 6 holes - take the **3 best** scores

4 Person Four Ball

Take the 2 best scores on each hole.

Multiplier

Played in pairs under a Stableford format. The Stableford points for each player are multiplied. e.g.: $3 \times 2 = 6$, $3 \times 0 = 0$.

Practice Areas

1. Creek Side of 18th Fairway

Practice from teeing area towards practice green only. No return of practice balls to be played. Practice onto the 18th green is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.

Practice onto the 18th fairway is permitted provided no Competitions are in progress. All players playing a Competition or a social round have right-of-way. Enquire at Pro Shop to find out if a competition is in progress.

2. Right Hand Side of 10th Fairway just forward of the 10th Tee except during competition.

Note: No practice is ever permitted around any green or fairway.

Order of Play

In Mixed Foursomes events male members must hit off the 1st Tee. On days when competitions arranged by the Match Committee are played, any member not taking part in the competition will only be permitted to hit off at the 1st Tee after all competitions have started.

In order to minimise congestion at the 1st Tee the Match Committee, General Manager or Starter may, at their discretion, permit competitors to start from a different tee, otherwise starting from the 5th, 10th, 13th and 15th tees or "**cutting in**" is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.

Saturday Competition

Play for Saturday Competitions will be from the 1st Tee.

During Winter months or at other times as considered necessary, the 10th Tee may be also be utilised, at the discretion of the Board.

Lady Members - Tuesday and Friday

These days are Lady Member Competition days. Lady Members have the right of the course. On Fridays a Medley Stableford Competition is also played before and after the ladies competition (see p12). Social play is permitted before and after the competitions at the discretion of the Starter.

Championship and Tournament Conditions

Men's Club Championship (Single)

- * Stroke event in three grades over 54 holes (3 rounds).
- * Grades: 'A' = 0 to 12, 'B' = 13 to 20 and 'C' = 21 to 36 + 55 years and over, and junior sections.
- * Event is open to all male 7 day Members and other eligible male members.
- * In the event of a tie for a Championship there will be an 18 hole playoff followed by sudden-death, if necessary. The Match Committee will decide the time.
- * Play will be from the 1st Tee unless decreed otherwise by the Match Committee. If the 10th Tee is utilised for the Club Championships then players will play from alternative tees each round.

Foursomes Championships (Members)

- * In the event of a tie the Match Committee will decide the time for the 18 hole playoff.
- * Play will be in sixes from the 1st Tee.
- * Team members may tee-off on the same holes or switch holes for the second round.

Foursomes Championships (Mixed)

- open to all members

- * Play will be in sixes from the 1st Tee.
- * Players will keep place on Time Sheet both rounds unless Match Committee decide otherwise.
- * Fees for both rounds to be paid before hitting off in first round.
- * Men to tee-off on odd numbered holes with the ladies teeing off on even numbered holes.
- * If the event is over 27 holes the last 9 holes will be played on hole 1 to 9. The tee-off order for the last 9 holes may be changed with the ladies to tee-off on the odd numbered holes and the men to tee off on the even numbered holes.

- * A sudden-death playoff will be used if there is a tie for the championship.

Fourball Best Ball Championship

- * Play will be from the 1st Tee unless decreed otherwise by the Match Committee.
- * In the event of a tie the Match Committee will decide a play-off time.
- * The handicap section will be decided as a 4 Ball Best Ball verses Par event. The scratch section will be decided as a stroke event.
- * An 18 hole playoff will be used if there is a tie for the championship.

Singles Knockout & Fourball Knockout

- * 32 players to qualify in Singles, 16 Pairs in the Four-ball.
- * Play on or before due date or forfeit.
- * If a match is all square after 18 holes play will go to the 19th etc. until a result is reached. Strokes will again be given where applicable if play extends beyond 18 holes.
- * If players fail to reach an agreement regarding date to play knockout, the player or players at the starting place (1st or 10th tee) by 1:00pm on the last due date and is ready to play shall be declared the winner.

Eclectic

- * The Eclectic Competition will be divided into Autumn and Spring Events.
- * All 5, 6 and 7 Day Members are eligible to enter.
- * Scores must be for a valid competition played at Waratah Golf Club (excludes Chook Runs, Ambrose & Foursomes events).
- * Temporary holes (such as 7th hole played as a Par 3) are not eligible for the Eclectic Competition.
- * Events will be run in divisions depending on number of entrants. Handicap divisions will be decided after final number of entries is known.

PATIOORLD W E Alexander Open (AGU Vardon Event) and the TITLEIST Easter Cup are open to all male members and visitors with a Golf Australia Handicap

- * All Players are equal, i.e. club members have no priority, but 7 day members have priority over 6, 5 and 1 day members.
- * All players will fill in entry forms and pay the full fee for the 2 days
- * An open ballot will be held if entries exceed the field limits. Long markers will be balloted out first.
- * In the event of a tie for 1st place in the W E Alexander Open, a sudden death playoff will be held over holes to be decided by the match committee.
- * A count back will decide all other categories and Team Event ties.

Allocating New Handicaps

After 3 cards have been submitted a handicap will be allocated to the member, the maximum for male members will be capped at 27.4 to begin.

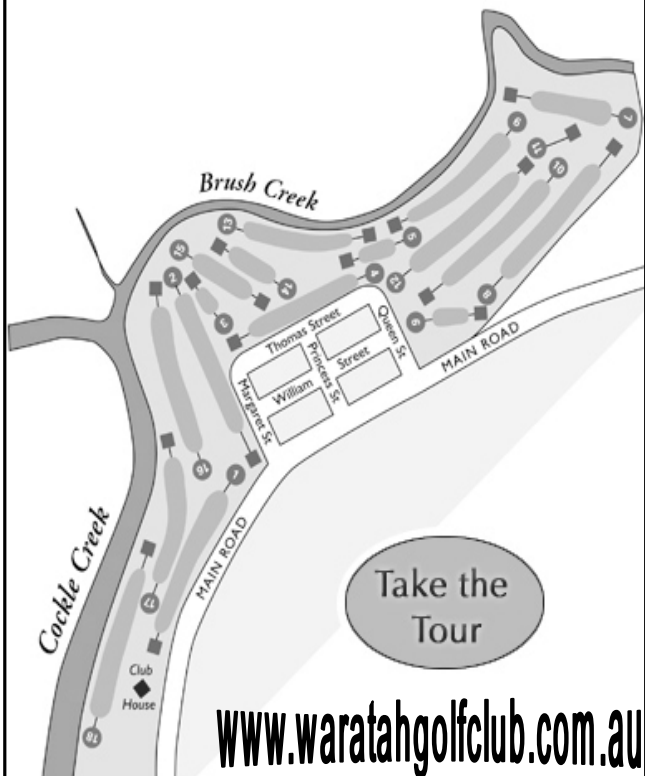
