



DRESS REGULATIONS POLICY

To maintain the standards of our club, all members and guests are required to adhere to the following dress code while on the golf course and in the clubhouse.

GOLF COURSE ATTIRE

ACCEPTABLE:

- Collared sports shirts or polo shirts
- Skivvies and golf shirts with abbreviated collars
- Tailored shorts, including cargo shorts, trousers, skorts, & skirts
- Socks (including ankle socks)
- Golf shoes with soft spikes
- Clean and tidy sports shoes

All approved clothing must be neat and tidy.

UNACCEPTABLE:

- Singlets, flannelette shirts, or sporting team shirts
- Crop tops or active wear tops
- Tracksuits, jeans, and overalls
- Stubbies, drawstring shorts, board shorts, or football shorts
- Industrial or work clothing, including high-visibility safety gear
- Clothing with offensive wording or logos
- Football boots, thongs, Ugh-boots, untidy or dirty footwear, or bare feet
- Golf shoes with metal spikes

CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE

Clubhouse dress regulations require all patrons to be neat and tidy.

Singlets and dirty or worn work apparel are strictly prohibited inside the clubhouse.

Please note: Any manager on duty reserves the right to direct patrons to leave the premises if, in their opinion, they have breached the dress regulations.
